You are receiving this letter because you have registered your child to play cricket at Coalpit Heath CC for 2024. This membership fee includes:

- all of your child's coaching (both indoor nets & outdoor training sessions)
- match fees
- loan of safety & cricket equipment during matches & training sessions (helmets, pads, gloves, bats, balls etc)

We have been awarded the ECB Clubmark Accreditation, therefore we adhere to the 'Safe Hands' Policy for Safeguarding Children in Cricket. All of the adults at the club who work with children must meet the necessary criteria and are vetted by the ECB. This includes the enhanced DBS and 'Barred List' Check (formerly known as CRB Check) and relevant Safeguarding and First Aid training.

Whilst we hope your child will be happy at the club, we understand that sometimes questions, concerns or difficulties may arise. Please feel able to raise these as soon as possible, so we can rectify things at the earliest opportunity. If you have a question regarding coaching, please approach the coach in the first instance. However, please do not interrupt coaching sessions, especially net practice, as this may distract the coaches when they need to be supervising the youth players. Our coaches will be happy to speak to you before or after training or at another convenient time. If you have questions about kit requirements, training times or travel arrangements please speak to the coaches.

I have also attached a copy of *CHCC Youth Cricket Policy* for your interest. A copy is also posted on the notice board in the entrance to the clubhouse, along with copies of the club's *Safeguarding Policy Statement* and *Code of Conduct*. I would ask all parents to read through carefully and encourage your child to read through and understand the expectations detailed in the policy, particularly the information regarding safety during net practice.

Outdoor coaching – Commencing during April in the outside net facilities at the club (depending on weather). Please correspond with your child's coach for days and times. To comply with safeguarding policy, we ask that all electronic communication (email, text, WhatApp) is between coaches and parents only; and not directly with children.
